High School Service Scholarship

This Service Scholarship is a one-time award of \$500.00, and will be given to an outstanding BHS senior who has been involved in service in his/her home school, church, and civic community (with emphasis given to Christian service). Application guidelines include:

- 1) Applicant must be a graduating senior (4 years with BHS), graduating both from BHS as well as concluding their program with the State of Florida.
- 2) Applicants must be attending a college, missions program, ministry program, or trade school full time in the upcoming fall as a full time student (a minimum of 12 hours class load is considered a full time.)
- 3) Please attach a list of community service hours describing all areas of community service you have been involved in including detailed hours of service during high school, and contact information for each organization. Applicants must list the name of each organization along with the number of hours he volunteered with each organization during his high school years. The review committee reserves the right to request a letter from each organization to verify this volunteerism.
- 4) Submit two written references with phone numbers. (Coach, community leader, pastor, teacher, scout leader)
- 5) Submit an essay of 500 words or less answering the following question:
How service and my home education experiences have prepared me to make a difference in this world for God's kingdom.
- 6) Completed applications & essays must be submitted to BHS by April 1st.
- 7) The Review Committee shall determine the winner based upon the following weight system:
High School Volunteerism: 75%
Essay: 25%.
- 8) The Review Committee reserves the right to personally interview the applicant at a mutually agreeable time and location.
- 9) The Review Committee's decision will be based upon a "weighted" system determined by the sum of the individual reviewer's choices.
- 10) It is incumbent upon the applicant to inform the Review Committee prior to the announcement of the winner, regarding any change of future educational plans. Failure to do so will render the applicant "ineligible" for consideration of the Scholarship.
- 11) BHS reserves the right to make the check out to the Educational Institution identified in the application.
- 12) In the event a Winner does not fulfill the educational plans for the upcoming fall term as identified in the application, the winner is required to refund the scholarship money back to BHS.
